This Week's Lesson Embroidered Heart Craft Directions


Materials:

Template
Cardstock or other sturdy paper (color is your choice)
Embroidery needle
Embroidery thread (colors are your choice)
Tape
Frame (optional)



Directions:

Print out template on sturdy paper you chose
Embroider lines with various colors you chose
Tape each colored thread in the back of paper to secure (this avoids knots in your creation)
Put in frame (optional)
Hang somewhere special to remind everyone that we should follow Jesus words and love each other
