

Craft Directions for Lesson, Little Things Matter

Materials

Cardstock Printed templates Craft moss or shredded paper Green construction paper (optional) Design paper (optional) Picture (optional) Scissors Glue Markers or crayons

Directions

Copy any of the templates you want to use, or just draw your own. Color flower pot. Cut out stems and leaves from green paper or color templates-cut out & glue onto pot. Glue moss or shredded paper on top of pot. Cut flower petals from design paper & glue flower shape or color flower template. Glue flower onto top of stem. Add picture in center of flower (optional). Put in a frame and hang (optional).

Use as a reminder to always be honest and truthful even when it's difficult to do. Even a little dishonesty is a big one!
